My Lord,

I beg permission to trespass
on your Lordship's valuable time in
submitting to your Lordship's consider-
ation certain correspondence which has
passed between the Venable the
Archdeacon of this Diocese and my-
self, respecting my attendance upon
the Quarterly Courts of the Church
and School Trustees. I trust it will
be sufficient that I disclaim all
personal considerations in this matter,
further than I feel disgraced in
being excluded from fulfilling my
duty as a Trustee, to which place
I was appointed by His Majesty,
and that such a course of proceed-
ing has been adopted towards me.
